Triggering Multiple Benefits for Urban Areas It's More than Renovation!



A delegation from **Renovate Europe** was in Strasbourg for two days (**29th and 30th April**) to undertake targeted actions to increase support for our work. The two actions were: on the **29th April, meetings were held with MEPs** to solicit their support for the REC Manifesto and the following morning the Campaign addressed the monthly meeting of the **URBAN Intergroup**, speaking to the theme of **Triggering Multiple Benefits for Urban Areas - It's More than Renovation!** The **13 meetings** that were held succeeded in galvanising more signatories, with **11 MEPs signing the Manifesto**. The total number of supporters has now reached **92 MEPs!**


